



Volunteer Opportunities

Life Learning Center is actively seeking individuals who hold a “PHD” in Life. Specifically, individuals with previous life experience (i.e. barriers such as poverty, unemployment, substance abuse) to share their experience and resiliency in facing and overcoming adversity. The Center strives to train successful individuals in our community to provide a leading example of how transformational change is achievable.

Faculty

Desired Service: 1-4 times/month, 4-8

hours/month

Responsible for the delivery of LLC curriculum; for conducting designed exercises; answering questions; assigning homework; and administering Candidate evaluations. The Center’s Managing Director will onboard and train faculty members* (see below for volunteer orientation dates).

Candidate Support Coordinator Desired Service: 1-2 hours/week for 12 consecutive weeks

Conduct 1-1 sessions with assigned Candidate during the 12-week program. Candidate Support Coordinators hold the Candidate accountable for his/her homework and goals while providing feedback and support. This includes utilizing LLC’s Candidate Support Manual while managing the Candidate’s individualized care menu for recommended resources. Candidate Support Coordinators will onboard and train with the Managing Director.

Interns

Desired Service: 15-20 hours/week

Interns will report directly to designated LLC supervisor to aid in coordination and execution of daily tasks needed. Interns are provided hands-on work experience with Candidates as well as networking opportunities for professional development. LLC is actively seeking the following types of interns: Master/Bachelor of Social Work, Marketing/Public Relations, Business Development, Communications, English, and/or Criminal Justice.

Ambassadors

Desired Service: 1-4

hours/week

Responsible for helping raise awareness about Life Learning Center and connecting with the community. Ambassadors will aid in coordinating and distributing marketing material (i.e. nametags, fliers). Ambassadors will have the opportunity to create content for social media channels. All Ambassadors will onboard, train and directly report to Marketing and Development Specialist.
